Administrative Office of the Courts,

As required by Utah Code § 54-24-303(5), the Public Service Commission (PSC) provides the following adjustment to the limitation on recoverable damages as described in Utah Code § 54-24-303(4) for inflation. Using the United States Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all urban consumers as reported by the Utah Department of Workforce Services,¹ the limitations on recoverable damage are increased by 2.95%.² Therefore, for a person who is not physically injured as a result of a fire, the limitation on recoverable damages is increased from \$100,000.00 to \$102,950.00 and for a person who is physically injured as a result of the fire, the limitation is increased from \$450,000.00 to \$463,275.00.

² The average CPI for calendar year (CY) 2023 is 304.7 and the average CPI for CY 2024 is 313.7, therefore, the increase due to inflation is $(313.7-304.7)/304.7= 2.95\%$.
