Dear Mr. Widerburg:

Pursuant to Commitment U3(2), incorporated in the Public Service Commission of Utah's *Report and Order* approving an affiliated interest transaction with Trapper Mining Inc. (Trapper) to amend a coal contract through which Trapper sells coal to PacifiCorp, Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District, and Platte River Power Authority (Buyers) for the operation of Craig Station. A verified copy of the First Amendment to Craig Station Sunset Coal Supply Agreement (Agreement) is included with this notice as Confidential Attachment A.

PacifiCorp, an Oregon corporation, holds a 29.14 percent ownership interest in Trapper, with Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District and Platte River Power Authority holding the remaining interest. Therefore, PacifiCorp's ownership interest in Trapper creates an affiliated interest between PacifiCorp and Trapper.

PacifiCorp will purchase coal from Trapper annually based on the coal that is needed to serve the Craig Station plant. This amount will vary every year. The main source of fuel for the coal-fired units of the Craig Station plant is Trapper. [REDACTED]

The Agreement with Trapper supports the public interest, because it will enable the Craig Station plant to continue to operate at a reasonable cost thereby allowing PacifiCorp to fulfill its obligation in providing efficient electric service to its customers.

PacifiCorp requests confidential treatment for Attachment A. The document labeled as confidential includes commercially sensitive information. This confidential business information is of significant commercial value, which could expose PacifiCorp to competitive injury and/or the potential for commercial fraud against it if disclosure is unrestricted. Confidential information is provided subject to Public Service Commission of Utah (UPSC) Rules R746-1-601–606.
