Re: **Docket No. 26-999-03**, Cliq Communications LLC d/b/a/ Cliq Mobile's Utah Telecom Registration / Status Verification Request.

Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has reviewed Cliq Communications LLC d/b/a Cliq Mobile's (Cliq or Company) filing and has determined the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) should acknowledge Cliq's request that no further action is required by the Commission at this time.

Issue

On May 28, 2026, the Company filed comments in this Docket requesting the Commission confirm the following:

1. Whether [Cliq] currently holds an active registration, certificate, license, telecommunications reporting account, tariff, docket, ETC/Lifeline designation, state USF/TRS/ relay account or similar obligation with the [Commission] in Utah:
2. If an active record exists, what voluntary surrender, withdrawal, cancellation, final report, final fee, surcharge, bond or other closure steps are required; and



3. If no active record exists, whether the [Commission] can confirm in writing that no further action is required with the [Commission] at this time.¹

Background

The Division has reviewed the request by the Company and recommends the Commission acknowledge that Cliq does not have any active record for the Company and can accept the email as final notification for the Company.

The Division has reviewed the Utah Universal Public Telecommunications Service Support Fund (UUSF), Eligible Telecommunication Carriers (ETC) designations, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) lists, and other forms and data bases to determine if Cliq has any active record in the State of Utah.

The Division has been unable to find any documents or data to suggest that Cliq has any active record with the Commission. Generally, cellular providers were not required to obtain a CPCN from the Commission.

Because there is no active record for Cliq, the Division recommends the Commission acknowledge the email communication from Cliq. The Commission could also indicate in its letter of acknowledgement that no further requirements, in the State of Utah, exist for Cliq.

Conclusion

The Division recommends the Commission acknowledge the voluntary email of Cliq seeking clarity on the status of the Company with the Commission. The proposed request will have no impact on Utah customers.
