On January 12, 2026, Aaron Kinikini on behalf of Lear & Lear PLLC submitted to the Utah Public Service Commission (PSC) a request for arbitration related to a damaged underground facility in Sandy, Utah, owned by Enbridge Gas Utah ("EGU"). The Underground Facilities Damage Dispute Board ("Board") issued a Notice Regarding Request for Arbitration the same date, requesting interested parties to submit, by February 11, 2026, any additional information they believe pertinent to the dispute and a statement indicating whether they agree to arbitration before the Board.

On February 10, 2026, EGU submitted a response declining to agree to engage in arbitration before the Board.

The Board is statutorily authorized to arbitrate disputes only "upon agreement of the disputing parties." Utah Code Ann. § 54-8a-13(5). Because EGU has declined to agree to arbitration, the PSC gives notice it has not forwarded Lear & Lear PLLC's request for arbitration to the Board and does not intend to take further action in this matter.
