SECOND SCHEDULING ORDER

ISSUED: July 3, 2003

By the Commission:

Pursuant to the Scheduling Order issued May 1, 2003, Autotel and Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed direct testimony on May 30, 2003, and Qwest filed rebuttal testimony on June 27, 2003. In addition, the Division of Public Utilities (Division) made a filing on June 27, 2003, recommending that a settlement conference be scheduled in an attempt to narrow the scope of this proceeding.

At the scheduling conference held on July 2, 2003, pursuant to the Scheduling Order, Autotel and Qwest agreed to accept the Division's recommendation to hold a settlement conference before proceeding further in this matter. All parties agreed to procedures related to that conference. In addition, Autotel and Qwest agreed to extend the deadline for a Commission decision, which would otherwise have been due on August 29, 2003, pursuant to their prior agreement noted in the Scheduling Order, to October 31, 2003.

Accordingly, the following schedule is set for this matter:

July 23, 2003: Deadline for Autotel and Qwest to file corrections, if any, to the Matrix of Issues attached to the Division's June 27, 2003 filing.

August 1, 2003: A settlement conference will be held beginning at 9:00 a.m. in Room 427, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.

In addition to Autotel and Qwest attempting to settle unresolved issues, the parties will attempt to agree upon a procedure and schedule for resolution of any remaining issues. At the conclusion of the settlement conference, a status and scheduling conference will be convened by the Administrative Law Judge of the Public Service Commission of Utah to receive a report of the parties and to set a further schedule in this matter.
