By The Commission:

Pursuant to agreement of the parties, the prior schedule is vacated and the following schedule is set:

Pre-hearing briefs and any final pre-filed testimony may be filed April 5, 2005.

Hearings will be held April 14 and 15, 2005, beginning 9:00 a.m., in Room 426, Large Hearing Room, 4th Floor, Heber M. Wells Building, 130 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.

To the extent that parties with similar or the same positions and arguments can coordinate among themselves the preparation and presentation of their evidence, it is highly encouraged by the Commission. Parties desiring to present information for the Commission's consideration should do so through the submission of pre-filed written testimony, rather than planning to rely upon the presentation of orally presented information or cross-examination, due to hearsay and procedural limitations that may be applied to such material and conduct. See, e.g., Utah Administrative Rule 746-100-10.

Discovery will continue under the following terms: Responses will be provided within 14 days; and within 7 days after March 22, 2005 (discovery during this latter period will be limited to new issues raised in the March 22, 2005, surrebuttal testimony).
