SECOND SCHEDULING ORDER

ISSUED: November 1, 2004

By The Commission:

A Scheduling Conference was held in this matter on October 20, 2004. Pursuant to agreement of the parties present, the following schedule is set.

1. Intervention sought by an interested party must be filed with the Commission on or before November 12, 2004.

2. Parties, other than the Division of Public Utilities, the Committee of Consumer Services and Qwest, will file their Rebuttal Testimony, to the testimony previously filed by Qwest on October 4, 2004, on or before November 19, 2004.

3. To the extent that parties with similar or the same positions and arguments can coordinate among themselves the preparation and presentation of their evidence, it is highly encouraged by the Commission. Parties desiring to present information for the Commission's consideration should do so through the submission of pre-filed written testimony, rather than planning to rely upon the presentation of orally presented information or cross-examination, due to hearsay and procedural limitations that may be applied to such material and conduct. See, e.g., Utah Administrative Rule 746-100-10.

4. The Division of Public Utilities and the Committee of Consumer Services will file their Rebuttal testimony, to the October 4, 2004, testimony filed by Qwest and the November 19, 2004, testimony filed by other parties, and Qwest

will file its Rebuttal testimony to the November 19, 2004, testimony, on December 15, 2004.

5. All parties will file their Surrebuttal testimony on January 7, 2005.

6. Interested parties may submit pre-hearing briefs on or before January 13, 2005.

7. Hearings will be conducted Thursday and Friday, January 20 and 21, 2005, at 9:00 a.m., in the Room #451,

Heber M. Wells State Office building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.

Individuals wishing to

participate by telephone may do so through a conference bridge telephone number, 1-415-646-2663, prior to the

beginning of the Scheduling Conference to ensure participation.

8. Discovery may continue to be conducted and responses shall be provided within twenty-one (21) days.
