PETITION TO INTERVENE**

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63-46b-9 and Utah Admin. Rule 746-100-7 Aspen Homes respectfully petitions the Public Service Commission of Utah (the "Commission") for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding concerning Qwest Corporation's Land Development Agreements tariff provisions in the state of Utah. In support of its petition, Aspen Homes represents and states as follows:

1. Aspen Homes is a Developer/ Home Builder, for developing and building over 250 homes per year in residential subdivisions throughout the state of Utah and specifically along the Wasatch Front.
2. As a Developer/ Home Builder, Aspen Homes is required by law to provide utilities, including telephone service to the building lots we develop and /or the homes we build in Utah. The outcome of Qwest Corporation's LDA Tariff socket could result in significant added costs to development and building time, aggravation and costs to Aspen Homes. Thus, the legal interests of Aspen Homes could be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

3. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding will not be impaired by allowing Aspen Homes to intervene.

WHEREFORE, Aspen Homes respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order granting Aspen Homes Petition to Intervene as a party in this docket, allowing Aspen Homes to participate to the full extent allowed by the rules of the Commission and by Utah Law.
