Dear Mr. Mooy:

We received a courtesy copy of the referenced letter this afternoon and noticed an error in the letter. There is reference to McMullin Homes, Inc. implying that they did not know about the Petition to Intervene that was submitted on their behalf. Mr. Bruce McMullin, President of McMullin Homes personally signed the Petition which we then hand delivered to the PSC. He has since decided that he would like to withdraw the Petition because he does not have the time to devote to responding to the data request sent by Qwest. He personally called me to inform me of that decision and stated that he had contacted Qwest to let them know he would not answer the data request. Footnote number two of Mr. Elmont's letter also states that the Certificate of Service was not signed. That is true for the original Certificate of Service as I did not realize that it had to be signed. When I found out my error, I did submit a revised Certificate of Service with the PSC the next day that was signed by me as I was the person that hand delivered the Petitions to the PSC. I will be happy to have Mr. McMullin respond to the PSC personally if you feel it is necessary, but I felt that this should be cleared up immediately.

I hope that this clears up the misinformation about our client McMullin Homes, Inc.
