PROCEDURAL NOTICE

By The Commission:

On December 28, 2005, Beehive Telephone Company, Inc. (“Beehive”) filed a Motion to Compel Frontier Telephone aka Citizens Telephone Co. (“Frontier”) to Cooperate with Qwest & Beehive to Provide Necessary Trunking alleging that Frontier had refused to provide adequate levels of trunk circuits to Beehive. On January 26, 2005, Frontier filed an Answer of Citizens Telecommunications of Utah denying that Frontier had refused to provision new circuits.

On February 2, 2005, Beehive filed a Certificate of Readiness for Trial and Request for Expedited Trial Setting stating that no pre-trial discovery is necessary in this docket and seeking expedited hearing. On February 15, 2005, Beehive filed a Withdrawal of Request for Expedited Trial Setting and Motion for Abatement of Discovery stating that Beehive and Frontier had begun negotiation to resolve the issues in this docket such that further discovery and expedited hearing were no longer required. The Commission took no action with respect to Beehive’s Motion for Abatement of Discovery.

On May 11, 2005, Beehive filed a Notice of Negotiation Breakdown, Request for Trial Setting, and Motion for Investigation and Discovery stating that, while the parties had reached agreement on the trunking issue, they were at an impasse regarding the proper exchange of billing records between Beehive and Frontier.

On May 26, 2005, pursuant to Notice issued on May 16, 2005, a Status and Scheduling Conference was held with the Administrative Law Judge. At this Conference, the parties agreed with the Administrative Law Judge that, given the resolution of the trunking issue and the substitution by Beehive of the billing issue, Beehive would file an amended complaint withdrawing its original petition for Commission action on the trunking issue and more particularly detailing its current complaint regarding billing issues.

Therefore, no further action will be taken in this docket until such time as Beehive files its amended complaint.
