ORDER GRANTING
JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS

ISSUED: May 24, 2005

By The Commission:

On March 3, 2005, Bonnie L. Reynolds (“Complainant”) filed a formal complaint against AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc. (“AT&T”). On April 21, 2005, the Commission issued a Notice setting hearing in this matter for May 19, 2005. On May 18, 2005, AT&T informed the Commission that AT&T and Complainant had reached a settlement and subsequently faxed to the Commission a copy of the Settlement Agreement and Joint Motion to Vacate Hearing and Dismiss the Proceeding. In response, on May 18, 2005, the Commission issued a Notice cancelling the hearing scheduled for May 19, 2005.

AT&T has agreed to release Complainant from her indebtedness to AT&T. Complainant has agreed to release AT&T from all claims described in her Complaint. Based on this agreement, the parties jointly seek dismissal of the Complaint.

Wherefore, based upon the foregoing information, and for good cause appearing, the Administrative Law Judge enters the following proposed

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The complaint filed herein is dismissed.
2. Pursuant to Utah Code 63-46b-12 and 54-7-15, agency review or rehearing of this order may be obtained by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission’s final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah

Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah

Code 63-46b-14, 63-46b-16 and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
