By The Commission:

On November 1, 2007, the Commission issued its Order Granting Qwest’s Motion for Leave to File Response to Level 3’s Reply Memorandum in Support of Motion for Entry of Order giving Qwest fifteen (15) days from the date of said Order to file its response to Level 3’s Reply. Level 3 was likewise provided ten (10) days from the date Qwest filed said response to reply to said response.

Qwest filed its response on November 19, 2007. On November 20, 2007, Level 3 filed its Motion for Extension to Time to File Sur-Reply (“Motion for Extension of Time”) seeking an extension to November 30, 2007, of the filing deadline for its reply to Qwest’s November 19, 2007, response. In support of its Motion for Extension of Time, Level 3 notes the current deadline includes two weekends and the Thanksgiving holiday and that counsel for Level 3 have professional and personal commitments that will make it difficult to file a complete and meaningful sur-reply with this time frame.
