By The Commission:

Notice is hereby given of the consideration by the Public Service Commission of Utah (the "Commission") of the approval of the Application for Rate Increase and USF Eligibility (the Application") filed by Carbon/Emery Telcom, Inc. ("Carbon/Emery Telcom") on June 17, 2005. If the Application is approved by the Commission residential local exchange rates would be increased by \$1.57 per month, from \$11.93 to \$13.50; business local exchange rates would be increased by \$3.63 per month, from \$19.37 to \$23.00. Carbon/Emery owns and operates the telephone exchanges in Price, East Carbon and Helper, Utah.

Therefore, unless later modified by the Commission, the following dates shall constitute the deadlines and schedule in this docket:

- Friday, September 16, 2005 – Deadline to file Petition to Intervene  
Please file Petitions with the Public Service Commission at 160 East 300 South, Heber M. Wells Building, Salt Lake City, Utah, 84111. Petitions to Intervene should include the reasons for intervention.
- Thursday, December 1, 2005 – Public Witness Hearing  
7:00 p.m., College of Eastern Utah, in Price, Utah- **Room location will be determined at a later date.**
- Tuesday, December 20, 2005 & - Hearing  
Wednesday, December 21, 2005 9:00 a.m., Room #426, Fourth Floor, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah 84111. This Hearing will be held to discuss the proposed sales of exchanges.

Individuals wishing to participate by telephone should contact the Commission at least two to three days prior to the hearing to make arrangements. On the day of the hearing, participants must call in to (801) 530-6716 or call toll-free 1-866-PSC-UTAH (1-866-772-8824) at least five minutes prior to the beginning of the hearing to ensure participation.
