ISSUED: November 17, 2006

On October 23, 2006, the Administrative Law Judge issued an Order Granting Motion for Extension of Deadline (“Order”) extending to November 16, 2006, the Joint CLECs’ deadline for filing of responsive testimony to the October 11, 2006, filing of Qwest Corporation (“Qwest”). This Order erroneously noted that, as of October 23, 2006, Qwest had not filed any response to the Joint CLECs’ Motion for Deadline for Filing Responsive Cost Information (“Joint CLEC Motion”). In fact, on October 19, 2006, Qwest had filed a Response to Joint CLECs’ Motion for Extension of Deadline for Filing Responsive Cost Information, and Motion for Opportunity to File Response Testimony (“Qwest’s Motion”), stating Qwest did not oppose the Joint CLECs’ request to extend their deadline to November 16, 2006, and requesting an opportunity to file response testimony to the Joint CLECs’ rebuttal. Qwest requests fifteen days from the date of filing of the Joint CLECs’ rebuttal testimony in which to file said response. On November 16, 2006, the Joint CLECs filed the Supplemental Testimony of Douglas Denney (Conversion Charges). To date, the Joint CLECs have filed no response to Qwest’s Motion.

Wherefore, based upon the foregoing information, and for good cause appearing, the Administrative Law Judge enters this Order granting Qwest’s Motion filed herein. Qwest shall have fifteen days from the date of filing of the Joint CLECs’ rebuttal testimony in which to

file any response. The Administrative Law Judge may permit additional responsive filings upon reasonable request, and may order further proceedings as appropriate.
