On March 1, 2006, Turner Telecommunications, Inc. ("Turner") filed a formal complaint on behalf of Complainant Stampin Up against Respondent AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc. ("AT&T") seeking "a total adjustment of \$28,857.21" in disputed charges.

On April 21, 2006, the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") filed a memorandum detailing its investigation of this matter and recommending the Commission schedule a hearing. On May 4, 2006, AT&T filed its Answer and Counterclaim noting AT&T had already made certain refunds to Complainant and arguing the complaint should be dismissed.
