APPLICATION

IDT America, Corp (“IDT” or “Applicant”), by its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Chapter 8b of Title 54 of the Utah Code; the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, Utah Admin. Code §§ 746-100 et seq.; and the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. §§ 151 et seq., hereby applies to the Utah Public Service Commission to expand its certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by the Commission in Docket 06-2464-01 on April 3, 2006, to provide competing local telecommunications services, including exchange access telecommunications services within the state of Utah. In support of its application, IDT provides the following information pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-349.

2. IDT America, Corp. is a wholly owned subsidiary of IDT Domestic Telecom, Inc., a Delaware corporation. IDT Domestic Telecom, Inc. is a wholly owned subsidiary of IDT Telecom, Inc., also a Delaware corporation. IDT Telecom, Inc. is a wholly owned

subsidiary of IDT Corporation, a Delaware corporation that is publicly traded on the New York Stock Exchange (IDT, IDT.C).

7. R746-349-3(A)(3). Facilities to be used. IDT does not intend to purchase its own facilities, and it intends to rely on the network elements and resold facilities of incumbent local exchange providers to offer service.
8. R746-349-3(A)(4). Services to be offered. IDT expects to offer a broad variety of local exchange services, primarily to residential and small business customers in Utah. IDT's initial line of local services will be comparable to that currently offered by the incumbent LECs. Initially, IDT plans to offer basic access line service, Optional Calling Features, Directory Assistance, Directory Services, and Operator Services.
 8. (a) R746-349-3(A)(4)(a). Classes of customers. IDT will offer its service primarily to residential and small business customers.
 8. (b) R746-349-3(A)(4)(b). Location of service. IDT will provide service to and from all points in Utah, including those exchanges with less than 5,000 access lines that are served by incumbent telephone corporations with fewer than 30,000 access lines.

9. R746-349-3(A)(5). Access to standard services. Once communication services are initiated, IDT will provide access to ordinary intraLATA and interLATA message toll calling, operator services, directory assistance, directory listings, and emergency services such as 911 and E911 either through its own operations or by purchasing those services from underlying carriers.
10. R746-349-3(A)(1), R746-349-3(A)(14). Public interest. Approval of IDT's application to expand its certificate will serve the public interest by creating greater competition in the local exchange marketplace, provide more bandwidth for higher-performance communications. The public convenience and necessity, therefore, will be served by the issuance of an expanded Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Applicant authorizing it to provide the services described in this application.

WHEREFORE, IDT America, Corp., respectfully requests that the Utah Public Service Commission allow IDT to amend its existing Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Docket 06-2464-01, on April 3, 2006.
