**RE: Federal Study Area Waiver  
Qwest Corporation and All West Communications, Inc.**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

By Report and Order Approving Stipulation (*In the Matter of the Request of All West Communications, Inc. for Revision of Exchange Boundaries*), Docket No. 02-2270-01, issued November 29, 2006, the Utah Public Service Commission ("Commission") approved a settlement stipulation by Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") and All West Communications, Inc. ("All West") to transfer seventy-three (73) building lots in the western portion of the Promontory Ranch Club from Qwest's Park City, Utah, exchange to All West's Jordanelle, Utah, exchange.

Qwest and All West have informed the Commission that they must obtain a waiver from the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") of their respective study area boundaries in order to complete the approved transfer of the service territory. This letter is written to confirm that the Commission has regulatory authority over the service territory transferred from Qwest to All West, and that the Commission does not object to grant of a federal study area waiver to reflect the resulting changes in the boundaries of the Utah study areas of Qwest and All West.
