3. Qwest shall file its Reply in support of its Motion no later than Monday, June 8, 2009;
4. Once Qwest and Verizon file their moving and responding papers, the Commission will determine the Motion, including whether it can rule upon the Motion by Thursday, June 11, 2009, and will also consider the other relief, including alternative relief, prayed for by Qwest.
