SYNOPSIS

The proposed indirect transfer of control appearing to present no detriment to the public interest, the Commission approved the same.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On August 27, 2008, Lightyear Network Solutions, LLC and Wherify Wireless, Inc (collectively Applicants) filed their joint application for approval of the indirect transfer of control of Lightyear to Wherify. The Division of Public Utilities reviewed the Application and filed its memorandum recommending approval on October 23, 2008. No one has opposed the Application. Other than the insertion of Wherify as the ultimate parent company of Lightyear, the proposed transaction will have no impact to Lightyear's customers. Lightyear will still continue to operate in Utah serving the same customers with the same prices as before.

ORDER

The Commission, having been fully advised in the matter, HEREBY ORDERS
THAT:

1. The Joint Application of the Applicants for the indirect transfer of control of Lightyear to Wherify is approved;
