Q.1 PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME AND WORK ADDRESS.

A.1 I am Jack Habiak. My work address is Room 2A127, One AT&T Way, Bedminster, New Jersey.

Q.2 BY WHOM ARE YOU EMPLOYED AND WHAT IS YOUR CURRENT POSITION?

A.2 I am employed by AT&T Corp., the parent company of AT&T Communications of the Mountain States and TCG Utah. I will collectively refer to all AT&T and TCG entities as "AT&T". I am currently a Director of Financial Analysis in AT&T's Global Access Management organization.

Q.3 WOULD YOU BRIEFLY DESCRIBE YOUR OCCUPATION AND YOUR EXPERIENCE?

A.3 My responsibilities include monitoring charges for interstate and intrastate switched access services billed by local exchange carriers. I have been in my current position for 12 years, and have worked for AT&T in various positions for a total of 25 years.

Q.4 WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF YOUR TESTIMONY IN THIS PROCEEDING?

A.4 I understand that All American Telephone Co. ("AA"), in its Amended Petition filed on August 31, 2009, has asked this Commission for an amendment to its Certificate to allow it to operate as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier ("CLEC") in territory currently served by Beehive Telephone Company. I will be speaking to whether AA's operations in Utah, and the proposed amendment, are in the public interest.

Q.5 WOULD GRANTING AA'S PETITION TO AMEND ITS CERTIFICATE SERVE THE PUBLIC INTEREST?

A.5 No, it would not. I have reviewed AT&T's business records associated with the interstate and intrastate switched access charge bills sent by AA to AT&T in Utah. The monthly number of minutes of use billed by AA is summarized in the chart annexed as Exhibit A. As shown on that chart, intrastate usage of services offered by AA by Utah callers using AT&T's network is extremely small, both as an absolute matter and as a percentage of overall usage. As a result, authorizing AA to operate in Beehive territory provides no appreciable benefit to the people of Utah.

Q.6 DOES THIS CONCLUDE YOUR DIRECT TESTIMONY?

A.6 Yes.
