The Division recommends that the Commission approve this tariff filing.

ISSUE:

The purpose of this filing is to reduce the monthly charge for a bundled service and remove the reference to non-regulated 100 long distance minutes.

BACKGROUND:

This filing reduces the monthly charge for the Frontier Digital Phone Essentials bundle, removes a reference to the non-regulated 100 long distance minutes and special condition that required customers to designate FCA as their long distance provider. It falls within the provision of *Utah Code* § 54-7-12(4), as amended and, therefore, could become effective without the necessity of a hearing before the Commission.
