MOTION OF FIRSTDIGITAL TELECOM FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A RESPONSE TO THE PETITION OF QWEST CORPORATION FOR ARBITRATION OF AN INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT WITH FIRSTDIGITAL TELECOM

FirstDigital Telecom, LLC (“FirstDigital Telecom”) hereby submits a motion with the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) for an extension of time to file a response to the Petition of Qwest Corporation (“Qwest”) for Arbitration of an Interconnection Agreement with FirstDigital Telecom. In support of this motion, FirstDigital Telecom states as follows:

On November 2, 2009, Qwest filed with the Commission a Petition for Arbitration of an Interconnection Agreement with FirstDigital Telecom pursuant to Section 252 of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 252. FirstDigital Telecom is currently negotiating with Qwest and is settling out on one final issue. The parties expect to reach an

agreement within the next week. FirstDigital Telecom represents to the Commission that Qwest does not oppose this motion. Granting an extension of time will allow FirstDigital Telecom and Qwest to complete the negotiations process and finalize an agreement.

WHEREFORE, FirstDigital Telecom respectfully requests until December 17, 2009, to file a response in this matter. It is FirstDigital Telecom's expectation that within the next week, FirstDigital Telecom and Qwest will complete negotiations.
