Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah (d/b/a Frontier Communications

Company of Utah), pursuant to Section 63-46b-9 <u>Utah Code Ann</u>. (2001) and Utah Admin. R.

746-100-7, respectfully petitions the Public Service Commission of Utah for leave to intervene in the above-captioned docket. Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah (hereinafter

- 1. Frontier is the Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier ("ILEC") serving the Moab and Lake Powell (a/k/a "Bullfrog") Exchanges in Utah in addition to other telephone exchanges in Grand, San Juan, Box Elder and Millard Counties. Frontier provides public telecommunications services in Utah pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity previously issued by this Commission.
- 2. Although Frontier has not been notified as required by Section 54-8b-2.1(3)(b) <u>Utah</u>

 <u>Code Ann.</u> (2001), it has come to Frontier's attention that on July 13, 2009, Beehive Telecom,

 Inc. ("Beehive") amended its initial Application in this Docket. Beehive's July 13, 2009,

 amendment limits the authority sought to the provision of public telecommunications services in

 Frontier's Moab and Lake Powell Exchanges. In its original application, Beehive sought

expanded authority to serve outside of Qwest's serving territory in exchanges of greater than

5,000 lines operated by carriers with fewer than 30,000 lines.

2. Section 54-8b-2.1(3)(b) <u>Utah Code Ann.</u> (2001) provides that telecommunications

corporations holding a certificate to provide public telecommunications service within the

geographic area where an applicant is seeking to provide telecommunications service shall be

provided notice of the application and granted automatic status as an intervener.

3. As the ILEC in the Moab and Lake Powell Exchanges, Frontier has a substantial

interest in this proceeding. The issues to be considered by the Commission will affect

Frontier's business interests and operations, as well as the interests of the subscribers, residential

and commercial, that Frontier serves in the Moab and Lake Powell Exchanges.

4. The interests of justice and the orderly conduct of these proceedings will not be

unduly impaired by allowing Frontier's participation. Since Beehive's amended application was

filed on July 13, 2009, Frontier's Petition to Intervene is prompt and timely.
