By The Commission:

On March 2, 2010, Carbon/Emery Telcom, Inc. (Company) contacted the Administrative Law Judge of the Commission via e-mail and stated it was in negotiations to settle this matter with the Division of Public Utilities (Division) and the Office of Consumer Services (OCS). The Company waived the 240-day time in which the Commission must resolve this matter. The Company also proposed that if the parties were unable to settle by March 9, 2010, it would file initial testimony no later than March 29, 2010, with remaining testimony deadlines and hearing to be set as required. Previously, the Division and the Company called the ALJ to state the Division had no opposition to the Company's request.

Based on the representations of the Company, the current scheduling order is stricken. If the parties do not settle by March 9, 2010, the Company shall file initial testimony by March 29, 2010, and shall request a scheduling conference to set remaining deadlines and a new hearing date.
