<b>Hearing</b>	A hearing on the Company's application will be conducted by the Administrative Law Judge of the Public Service Commission on <b>Monday, April 26, 2010</b> . It will commence at <b>9:00 a.m. on the fourth floor in hearing room 451</b> , Heber M. Wells State Office building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.

Public witness testimony will begin promptly at 4:30 pm and will conclude about 5:30 pm. If no witnesses appear (either in person or telephonically) by 4:35 pm, public witness testimony will conclude. If, however, a party desires to appear during the public witness portion, but cannot appear until after 4:30 pm, that party shall contact the Commission Secretary, Julie Orchard, at 801-530-6716, to inform the Commission of the time which the party shall give testimony.

Discovery turn-around time is 14 calendar days.
