Judge Arredondo-

We received Integra's request for supplemental authority, including its new arguments about new dates and its objections to the Joint Applicants' settlements with the Division of Public Utilities and the Office of Consumer Services, this morning. CenturyLink and Qwest have not yet had an opportunity to respond to last week's motion to delay the schedule, nor to the filing this morning. Moreover, although Integra has asked for expedited consideration, we are not aware that the Commission or Your Honor has granted that request, and thus the Joint Applicants' response is not due yet. Accordingly, we ask that the Commission not rule on Integra's motion until the Joint Applicants have filed their response and the Commission has reviewed it.

Nevertheless, the Joint Applicants do intend to respond to the motion and supplemental filing in a timely fashion. We ask that Your Honor give us until about 1:00 p.m. MDT tomorrow in which to file our response. We will also respond to the Integra motion to compel as well.
