Subject: Complete Filing Requirement in South Central Utah Telephone Association, Inc's Application for USF Eligibility Docket No. 10-0052-01.

ISSUE:

On November 2, South Central Utah Telephone Association, Inc. (SCUTA) pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §54-8b-11, §54-8b-15, and Rules R746-360 and R746-700 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, filed an application with the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) for State Universal Service Fund (USF) Eligibility Per Utah Code §54-7-12 (2) (b) (ii), parties have 14 days to challenge the completeness of the application. The completeness of a filing is defined by Commission rule R746-700-40.

RECOMMENDATION (Accept as Complete Filing):

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has reviewed the Application, as filed, and believes it should be accepted as a complete filing as contained in the Commission's rule R746-700-40.

DISCUSSION:

The Division has reviewed the application and compared the material filed with the application to the rules in R746-700-40. Based on the review, the Division concludes that SCUTA has filed information in each required area. Therefore, the Division is not challenging the completeness of SCUTA's filing. Although the Division has verified that information for each rule exists as required, the Division makes no judgment regarding the accuracy of the information or whether the Division agrees with the information as filed.

The Division requests that the Commission hold a Scheduling Conference in this Docket.
