By The Commission:

Pursuant to Utah Code § 54-4-2, the Commission hereby commences an investigation of the compliance of All American Telephone Company (“AATCO”) with the Commission’s prior orders to cease operating in Utah.

In the Report and Order dated April 26, 2010, in Docket No. 08-2469-01, the Commission revoked AATCO’s certificate of public convenience and necessity, and ordered AATCO to cease operating in Utah within 30 calendar days. On July 6, 2010, in its Order on Application for Review and Rehearing and Request for Reconsideration, the Commission affirmed its April, 26, 2010, order.

The Commission hereby directs the Division of Public Utilities, pursuant to Utah Code §§ 54-4a-1(c), (d) and (e), to investigate AATCO’s compliance with the aforementioned orders. The Division shall report its findings to the Commission within 60 days of the date of this Order, either verifying AATCO’s compliance or making any recommendations it feels are necessary to secure compliance. If appropriate, the Division shall also take all actions necessary to enforce compliance with Commission orders.
