By The Commission:

In the Report and Order dated April 26, 2010, in Docket No. 08-2469-01, the Commission revoked AATCO's certificate of public convenience and necessity, and ordered AATCO to cease operating in Utah within 30 calendar days. On October 26, 2010 the Commission directed the Division of Public Utilities (Division) to investigate AATCO's compliance with the April 26, 2010 Order.

In its interim report filed December 28, 2010, the Division stated that, based on data requests received from one interexchange carriers (IXC), it appears that "AATCO has ceased all material operations in the state of Utah and is in compliance with the Commission order." The Division is waiting for additional information to render a final opinion, however.

Therefore, the Division is ordered to gather information needed to render a final opinion to the Commission, and give the Commission a status update or final recommendation on March 8, 2011.
