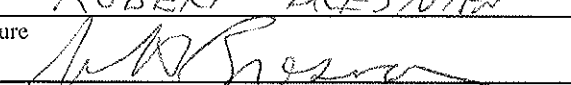
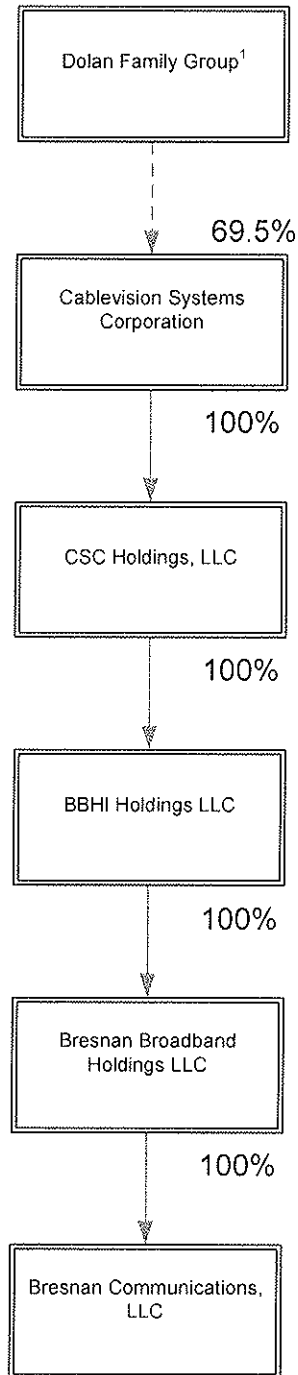

Eligibility for CARS License Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 78.13

Control and Ownership of Cablevision Systems Corporation

On April 8, 2010, Cablevision System Corporation (“CVC”) filed a Proxy Statement with the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”), which contained information concerning stock ownership as of March 31, 2010.^{1/} As of that date, the only entity that beneficially owned 5% or more of the combined voting interest of any class of stock of CVC was a group comprised of Charles F. Dolan and his family, which collectively beneficially owned 69.5% voting interest in CVC. Members of the Dolan family have formed a “group” for purposes of Section 13D of the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934 (the “Dolan Family Group”).^{2/}

The members of this group are: Charles F. Dolan, individually and as a trustee of the Charles F. Dolan 2009 Revocable Trust (the CFD 2009 Trust”), the Charles F. Dolan 2008 Grantor Retained Annuity Trust #2 (the “2008 GRAT #2”), the Charles F. Dolan 2009 Grantor Retained Annuity Trust #1 (the “2009 GRAT #1”), the Charles F. Dolan 2009 Grantor Retained Annuity Trust #2 (the “2009 GRAT #2”), the Charles F. Dolan 2009 Grantor Retained Annuity Trust #3 (the “2009 GRAT #3”) and the Charles F. Dolan 2010 Grantor Retained Annuity Trust #1 (the “2010 GRAT #1”); Helen A. Dolan, individually and as a trustee of the Helen A. Dolan 2009 Revocable Trust (the HAD 2009 Trust”), the Helen A. Dolan 2009 Grantor Retained Annuity Trust #1 (the “HAD 2009 GRAT #1”), the Helen A. Dolan 2009 Grantor Retained Annuity Trust #2 (the “HAD 2009 GRAT #2”) and the Helen A. Dolan 2010 Grantor Retained Annuity Trust #1; James L. Dolan; Thomas C. Dolan; Patrick F. Dolan; Kathleen M. Dolan, individually and as a co-trustee of the Charles F. Dolan Children Trust fbo Kathleen M. Dolan, the Charles F. Dolan Children Trust fbo Deborah Dolan-Sweeney, the Charles F. Dolan Children Trust fbo Marianne Dolan Weber, the Charles F.
