3 THE COURT: This is the matter --
4 Docket No. 10-2476-02, In the Matter of the
5 Application of Bresnan Broadband of Utah for Informal
6 Adjudication of Indirect Transfer of Control.

7 And let's take appearances, beginning with
8 Mr. Nelson.

9 MR. NELSON: Thor Nelson of the law firm of
10 Holland & Hart, appearing today on behalf of Bresnan.

11 MR. SNARR: Steve Snarr, also with Holland &
12 Hart, on behalf of Bresnan.

13 THE COURT: Any other attorneys that need to
14 make an appearance?

15 MR. OLSEN: This is Michael Olsen, Senior
16 Vice President for Legal, Regulatory, and Legislative
17 Affairs for Cablevision.

18 THE COURT: All right, thank you.

19 And with the Division?

20 MR. GINSBERG: Michael Ginsberg for the
21 Division of Public Utilities. And Ron Slusher also is
22 here for the Division.

23 THE COURT: All right, thank you. We'll note
24 that the Division does have their witness who
25 submitted the recommendation recommending the

1 Commission approve the application.

2 The Commission sent notice -- public notice
3 and notice of hearing on July 21st, setting a deadline
4 for comments in opposition to the application. The
5 Commission will note that there has been no opposition
6 filed.

7 The Applicants have made a prima facie case
8 in their application that this matter should be
9 approved -- the informal adjudication of indirect
10 transfer of control should be approved, that it's in
11 the public interest, and it's just and reasonable.

12 And Mr. Ginsberg, would you proffer that your
13 witness's testimony would be the same?

14 MR. GINSBERG: Yeah. If Ron Slusher was
15 called as a witness, he filed a memorandum with the
16 Commission on July 20th recommending that the
17 application be approved. And that the structure that
18 is being proposed would be in the public interest and
19 wouldn't affect the rates, terms, or conditions of
20 customers in Cedar City.

21 THE COURT: All right, thank you.

22 And Mr. Nelson, would your application remain
23 the same?

24 MR. NELSON: It would. And we have nothing
25 further to add. Thank you, your Honor.

1 THE COURT: Okay then. Anything else that we
2 need to discuss today? Mr. Nelson?

3 MR. NELSON: We have nothing further to add.
4 And have witnesses available only in the event that
5 you or the Commission have questions.

6 THE COURT: All right then. Then since
7 there's been no opposition, the Commission will assume
8 that the approval of the transaction is in the public
9 interest. And I'll make a recommendation to the
10 Commission that they approve this application, and
11 will enter an order accordingly. Thank you.
