Dear Ms. Jacobson,

The Public Service Commission of Utah (“PSC”) reviewed the November 30, 2017 filing by Virgin Mobile USA, LP, dba Assurance Wireless Brought to You by Virgin Mobile (“Virgin Mobile”), of an update to its lifeline service offering. The PSC also reviewed the December 21, 2017 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (“DPU”). The DPU states Virgin Mobile’s filing fulfils the notification requirement for changes to Virgin Mobile’s Lifeline service offering.¹ The DPU concludes there is no reason to deny the changes and recommends the PSC acknowledge the changes.

Based on the PSC’s review of the filing and the DPU’s response, the PSC acknowledges receiving the notice of changes to Virgin Mobile’s Lifeline service offering as described in its November 30, 2017 filing, with a December 1, 2017 effective date as indicated in the filing.
