**DIVISION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES'
MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING**

The Utah Division of Public Utilities, by and through undersigned counsel, hereby respectfully moves the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) to continue the hearing on the merits of Petitioner Virgin Mobile USA, LP's Petition for Limited Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier, which hearing is scheduled for January 26, 2011. As the Commission is aware, Virgin Mobile has not produced its contract with Solix, Inc., which will provide Lifeline administration services

if Virgin Mobile's Petition is granted. The Office of Consumer Services (Office) has moved to compel production of the contract and for sanctions, among which include rescheduling the hearing and allowing additional discovery concerning the contract and Lifeline administrative services that will be provided. In its Response to the Office's Motion to Compel and Motion for Sanctions, Virgin Mobile has offered to supplement its responsive testimony to further clarify Virgin Mobile's process for determining Lifeline eligibility and its process for verification of continuing eligibility for Lifeline customers.

Virgin Mobile's contract with Solix is relevant to assessment of the merits. Production of the testimony or the contract under a protective order if the Commission so orders this afternoon, just over twenty-four hours before the hearing, will not allow sufficient time for the Division to effectively proceed on the merits. The Division therefore proposes that
