By The Commission:

The Commission held a technical conference in the above-entitled matter on August 22, 2012. At this conference, the Department of Workforce Services (“DWS”) presented information on the eRep system discussed in the Division of Public Utilities’ (“Division”) memo, filed with the Commission on July 23, 2012. The conference participants discussed the capabilities of the system to provide eligibility verification for telecommunications customers seeking or receiving Lifeline service under Utah Admin. Code R746-341. To facilitate further evaluation of the eRep system, the conference participants agreed upon the following actions:

1. **Friday, August 31, 2012** – The Division will file a report describing the initial and ongoing eligibility verification requirements Utah’s Lifeline program must meet to satisfy state and federal mandates, in particular the provisions of the FCC’s Transformation Order.
2. **Monday, September 10, 2012** – Parties may file comments on the Division’s report.
3. **Monday, September 17, 2012** – DWS will file a written overview of how the eRep system could be adapted to satisfy the requirements described in the Division’s report, and the startup and ongoing costs of providing the required eligibility verification services.

4. **Monday, September 24, 2012** – The Commission will hold a technical conference beginning at **9:00 a.m. in Room 401, Heber M. Wells Bldg, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.** DWS will demonstrate the eREP system so that participants may evaluate its capacity to meet cost-effectively the Lifeline program requirements.

Participants attending by telephone should then call the Public Service Commission at the same number listed above five minutes prior to the conference to ensure participation.
