On January 4, 2011, the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) approved the Indirect Transfer of Control of Qwest Corporation, Qwest Communications Company, LLC and Qwest LD Corporation (“Operating Entities”) to CenturyLink. The merger that was the subject of the Commission’s January 4, 2011 Order closed on April 1, 2011. As a result of the merger, the Operating Entities will operate with a doing business as (“dba”) name of CenturyLink effective August 8, 2011. The Business Name Registration/DBA Applications filed with the Department of Commerce are attached hereto and identify the dba’s for the Operating Entities as follows:

Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC
Qwest Communications Company, LLC d/b/a CenturyLink QCC
Qwest LD Corp. d/b/a CenturyLink LD

The legal entity names will remain unchanged. A revised title page of Qwest’s access tariff has been filed with the Commission to reflect the dba change. Further, CenturyLink will submit revisions to its price list to reflect the dba change. Additional Qwest entities that operate in Utah, but not under the jurisdiction of the Commission, will also operate with a doing business name of CenturyLink.
