By The Commission:

On December 5, 2011, BellSouth Long Distance, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Long Distance Service (“BellSouth”) filed a notice and attestation seeking cancelation of its certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide local exchange service in the State of Utah (“Certificate”).

In its notice BellSouth states it has made the business decision to no longer be a telecommunications carrier of resold and facilities-based local exchange service or pursue local exchange customers in this state. BellSouth attests it serves no local exchange customers, operates no telephone numbers, and derives no revenue from local exchange telecommunications services in Utah. BellSouth further attests it has never had local customers in Utah.

For these reasons, BellSouth requests the Commission to cancel its Certificate and associated authority to offer telecommunications services in this state.

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) has reviewed the request and recommends approval. The Division confirms that as of December 8, 2011, the date of the Division’s memorandum to the Commission, BellSouth has no local exchange customers in Utah.

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ORDER

Based on the foregoing facts, BellSouth's request is approved and its Certificate is hereby canceled.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
