In accordance with R746-405 of the Public Service Commission's Rules, John Staurulakis, Inc. (JSI) is filing an original and two (2) copies of attached new Intrastate Access Tariff on behalf of Central Utah Telephone, Inc. and Subsidiaries, which consists of, Bear Lake Communications, Inc., Central Utah Telephone, Inc. and Skyline Telecom ("Companies").

The purpose of this filing is to reflect recently enacted FCC rules pursuant to the FCC's Report and Order and Further Notice of Rulemaking, Docket No. WC Docket No. 10-90, *et al.*, FCC 11-161 (Released November 18, 2011).¹ The FCC's Rules in this Order became effective on December 29, 2011. This tariff filing establishes a new Intrastate Access Tariff for the Companies and supersedes and cancels any affiliation or concurrences that may currently exist between the Companies and any other existing Intrastate Access Tariff, effective July 1, 2012.

This tariff filing is being filed electronically, and it consists of four (4) electronic files which contains Sections 1 through 17 of the Companies Intrastate Access Tariff PSC Utah No. 2.

Attachment 1 to this transmittal letter is being submitted in order to provide a narrative description of the assumptions underlying the rates being filed with this tariff. However, the details supporting Attachment 1 have been determined to be confidential, and are not being included with this tariff filing. The minutes-of-use, cost and rate information required to be submitted with this filing is highly confidential and is not available through any source other than the companies or their authorized agents. Furthermore, this information could have economic value to potential competitors, and in a competitive telecommunications marketplace, this type of information is highly sensitive and its public disclosure would place the companies at a competitive disadvantage. Accordingly, only the general rate design information is being submitted to the Commission today as Attachment 1 to this transmittal letter, which is being filed in conjunction with this Intrastate Access Tariff filing.
