
The purpose of this filing is to adjust the "transitional" rate defined by the recently enacted FCC rules pursuant to the FCC's Report and Order and Further Notice of Rulemaking, Docket No. WC Docket No. 10-90, *et al.*, FCC 11-161 (Released November 18, 2011).¹ The FCC's Rules in this Order became effective on December 29, 2011, with a provision for the establishment of transitional rates to become effective on July 1, 2012.

¹ *In the matter of Connect America Fund, A National Broadband Plan for Our Future, Establishing Just and Reasonable Rates for Local Exchange Carriers, High Cost Universal Support, Developing an Unified Intercarrier Compensation Regime, Federal State Joint Board on Universal Service, Lifeline and Link-Up, Universal Service Reform Mobility Fund*, Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, *et al.*, FCC 11-161, Released November 18, 2011 ("ICC Reform Order").

Further clarification and data required by the FCC related to the calculation of these rates resulted in a reduction to the defined and calculated intrastate terminating transitional rate for Emery. The transitional rate was adjusted from the originally filed amount of \$0.003659 down to \$0.001795 per end office terminating minutes of use as reflected in the attached revised Page 37. No other changes to Page 37 were made.
