Re: Agreement filing in the Matter of the CenturyLink Local Services Platform ("CLSP")
Interconnection Agreement between CenturyLink QC and Spectrotel, Inc. per Docket No. 12-049-04.

RECOMMENDATION (acknowledge):

The Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge the receipt of this CenturyLink Local Services Platform ("CLSP") Interconnection Agreement.

EXPLANATION:

On March 20, 2012, CenturyLink QC ("CenturyLink") filed the CenturyLink Local Services Platform ("CLSP") Interconnection Agreement per the above-referenced docket in accordance with § 54-8b-2.2(1) (d) of the *Utah Code*. This Agreement had been fully executed through voluntary negotiations on March 05, 2012 with Spectrotel, Inc. ("Spectrotel").

The Division has reviewed the above-mentioned Agreement between CenturyLink and Spectrotel and sees no reason to reject it. Specifically, the Division believes that the Agreement was negotiated in good faith and without unfair discrimination. Both parties also recognize that, to the extent that the existing rules are changed, vacated, dismissed, stayed or modified, this Agreement and all contracts adopting all or part of this Agreement will be amended to reflect such modification or change of the existing rules. Therefore, the Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge the receipt of this Interconnection Agreement.
