Dear Mr. Gatchell,

On June 7, 2012, the Utah Public Service Commission received a request for a waiver of Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements by Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink (CenturyLink). The request is for four blocks of 1,000 sequential numbers in the 385 NPA, Lehi Rate Center, to meet the needs of a customer in the community.

Through correspondence, CenturyLink has substantiated a verifiable need for the requested numbers. The customer is moving from the Orem Rate Center to the Lehi Rate Center and will return the numbers it is currently using in the Orem Rate Center.

Based on the authority delegated to the states in paragraph 61 of the FCC's Third Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization, the Utah Public Service Commission grants CenturyLink's request for a waiver of the Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements, thereby allowing PA/NeuStar to provide CenturyLink with the requested telephone numbers in the 385 NPA, Lehi Rate Center.
