RE: Docket No. 11-049-T03 Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink filing to modify tariff language for the Identification and Rating of VoIP-PSTN Traffic to be in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's April 25, 2012 Second Order of Reconsideration in WC Docket No. 10-90, etc., FCC release No. 12-47.

ISSUE:

Qwest Corporation (Qwest) dba CenturyLink is filing this addition to its existing Access Service Tariff, to propose the modification of tariff language for the Identification and Rating of VoIP-PSTN traffic to be in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's April 25, 2012 Second Order of Reconsideration in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, etc. (FCC 12-47).

RECOMMENDATION: Approve Tariff Modification
