RE: Navajo Communications Company– Lifeline & Link Up

Dear Ms. Orchard:

Enclosed please find an original and two copies of the enclosed tariff filing for Commission review and approval.

The purpose of this filing is to update the Lifeline and Link Up tariff to comply with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Docket No. FCC-12-11, Lifeline and Link Up Reform and Modernization.

The following changes are effective April 1, 2012:

1. ETCs Federal Lifeline Support will equal \$9.25 per month for each eligible non-Tribal Lifeline subscriber, which is a 75 cent reduction in federal support; and
2. Link Up support will only be available to Tribal Lifeline subscribers; and
3. Tribal Lifeline subscribers will receive a 100 percent reduction, up to up to \$100.00, of the customary charge for commencing service.

It is respectfully requested that this filing become effective on April 1, 2012.
