Re: Advice Letter--All West Communications, Inc. /Tariff Filing

To the Commission:

In accordance with R746-405 of the Public Service Commission's Rules, All West Communications, Inc. ("All West") hereby files the original and two (2) copies of the following Revised Tariff Sheets of All West Communications, Inc. P.S.C.U. No. 1 Access Service Tariff on file with the Commission:

1. 6th Revised Sheet No. 208, canceling 5th Revised Sheet No. 208

As previously indicated this filing revises All West's Terminating Local Transport Termination Charge from \$0.16185/min to \$0.026/min. As you will recall, in June of 2012, All West revised its local transport termination charge as required in the FCC's November 18, 2011 Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, etc. ("FCC Transformation Order"). The rate change was originally made in accordance with paragraph 801 of the FCC Transformation Order and 47 CFR Section 51.909, and was effective July 1, 2012.

Unfortunately, the FCC subsequently required NECA to recalculate the RLEC's eligible recovery from the CAF, and NECA determined that All West had reduced its intrastate terminating switched access rate too far. Thus, All West is raising its Terminating Local Transport Termination Charge to \$0.26/min. This filing does increase one rate, but does not cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other Tariff section.

All West requested an effective date for this filing of November 5, 2012, which would have been less than the required thirty (30) day notice period pursuant to R746-405-2.E.3. However, the Commission did not issue an order approving the tariff rates to be effective early.

Nevertheless, it has now been thirty one (31) days from the date the Tariff change was submitted. Thus, pursuant to R746-405-2.E.2, the tariff shall become effective after not less than thirty calendar days. We are submitting the Tariff with an effective date of November 12, 2012 for inclusion in the Division Tariff books.
