Re: In the Matter of the Application of Sage Telecom, Inc., to cancel their Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide Local Exchange Services in the State of Utah Docket No. 12-2485-01.

RECOMMENDATION (Approval):

The Division has reviewed the request by Sage Telecom, Inc. ("Sage") to have their Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to provide Local Exchange Services in the State of Utah cancelled and recommends the Commission grant this request.

EXPLANATION:

On May 02, 2012, Sage filed with the Commission a request to have their CPCN cancelled. The Division has reviewed this request and found the following:

Sage is a Texas corporation, headquartered 3300 East Renner Road, Suite 350, Richardson, Texas 75082. Sage was issued a Certificate to provide telecommunications services in Utah on December 10, 2007 in Docket No. 07-2485-01. They currently do not provide any telecommunications services in the State of Utah. It appears they have complied with the rules for exiting as required under Administrative Rule R746-350.
