RELINQUISHMENT OF ELIGIBLE
TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER
STATUS

ISSUED: January 18, 2017

On April 8, 2013, the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) granted eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) status to Total Call Mobile, Inc. (Total Call) in Docket No. 12-2561-01.

On December 16, 2016, Total Call applied to the Commission for approval to relinquish its ETC designation, effective December 31, 2016.

On January 17, 2017, the Division of Public of Utilities (Division) filed a memorandum in this docket, recommending that the Commission approve Total Call's application. In recommending approval, the Division noted that Total Call has transferred its customers to another carrier and has complied with all regulations for exiting the telecommunications market. In addition, the Division confirmed that numerous ETC-designated wireless providers are available to customers within Total Call's service areas.

ORDER

Given the foregoing, Total Call Mobile, Inc.'s petition to relinquish its eligible telecommunications carrier status is granted, effective December 31, 2016.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
