Dear Mr. Kirk Lee:

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has recommended that the Commission not approve the requested promotional rates submitted by Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah d/b/a Frontier Communications of Utah (Citizens) on September 18, 2013. The Division points out that an exemption from the currently approved tariff rate would be required for such a program to be put in place. The Division states: "The DPU recognizes that Citizens wants to attract new customers and retain existing customers by providing competitive pricing on a short term basis that does not affect their basic rates. That option is available through an exemption by the Commission in Utah Code Section 54-8b-3 for which Citizens can apply."

Having received no response from Citizens to the Division's memorandum filed in this Docket, and for the reasons outlined in the Division's memorandum, the Commission does not approve Citizen's proposed promotional offering.
