Integra Telecom of Utah, Inc., Electric Lightwave, LLC, and Eschelon Telecom of Utah, Inc. (collectively "Integra"), respectfully provide this update to its October 11, 2013 comments to responding to Qwest Corporation dba: CenturyLink QC's ("CenturyLink"), August 30, 2013 petition requesting Commission approval of the 2013 Additions to its Non-Impaired Wire Center List.

Background

On August 30, 2013, CenturyLink filed a petition with the Commission requesting approval of the 2013 Additions to its Non-Impair Wire Center List ("2013 Application"). In the 2013 Application CenturyLink requested that the Clearfield (CLFDUTMA) and the Kearns (KRNSUTMA) wire center classifications change from Tier 3 to Tier 2 based on the number of fiber-based collocations in each central office. The impact and permanency of changes in wire center classifications led Integra to undertake a careful evaluation of the highly confidential data CenturyLink provided to Integra.

On October 11 2013, Integra submitted comments in this docket which provided the status of its evaluation. At the time of its comments, Integra reported it had not received a response from one carrier that it needed to confirm the presence of three fiber-based collocators in the Clearfield and Kearns wire centers. Because the record was insufficient to support CenturyLink's request to change the wire center classifications of the Clearfield and Kearns

offices, Integra objected to CenturyLink request. In addition, Integra requested that it be allowed to update the record on October 18, 2013 to provide an update on its verification efforts.

Integra received a response from one the remaining carrier. This carrier's response verified the three fiber-based collocators needed to change the classification of the Clearfield and Kearns wire centers from Tier 3 to Tier 2.

Conclusion

Integra completed its evaluation verifying the number of fiber-based collocators in Clearfield and Kearns, therefore, Integra withdraws its previous objections to CenturyLink's request to change the classifications of Clearfield and Kearns from Tier 3 to Tier 2 wire centers. Integra is unopposed to CenturyLink's application that the following wire centers will be classified as below, effective upon the Commission's order:
