ORDER

On August 2, 2013, the Commission issued an order approving a \$2.33 monthly increase per residential line for Beehive Telephone Company (“Company”), effective July 1, 2013, subject to an audit to be completed by the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”).¹ On September 5, 2013, we received the Division’s audit and recommendation to approve the requested rate increase based upon a finding that the Company will not be over earning with the rate increase and that it is warranted, just and reasonable.² Accordingly, we affirm our August 2, 2013, order.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
