NOTICE

On May 1, 2013, TNCI Operating Company LLC (“TNCI”) and Trans National Communications International, Inc. (“Trans National”) (collectively, “Applicants”) filed a joint application for Commission approval of TNCI to acquire customers and certain assets of Trans National. Applicants seek adjudication of the application pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-4-30. Applicants also seek informal adjudication pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-110-1.

The Commission gives notice that the application has been filed, that any interested party may submit comments on the application within 14 days following this notice, and may submit reply comments within 21 days following this notice.

Wells State Office Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah. The hearing will be conducted by the Administrative Law Judge for the Public Service Commission. counsel, joined by local counsel, or otherwise admitted by a motion *pro hac vice* pursuant to Commission rules (Utah Admin. Code R746-100-6(B)).

Individuals wishing to participate in the hearing by telephone should contact the Public Service Commission two days in advance by calling (801) 530-6716 or (toll-free) 1-866-PSC-UTAH (1-866-772-8824). Participants attending by telephone should then call the Public Service Commission at one of the numbers posted above five minutes prior to the hearing to ensure participation.
