By The Commission:

It has come to the attention of the Commission that there are errors in the recent Order Approving Transfer of Control issued by the Commission on October 1, 2013 (“Order”). The errors occur on page three of the Order. The first error is in the second sentence of the first full paragraph, which reads: “Mr. Slusher further testified that a transfer of control in this docket is just, reasonable, and in the public interest. See id. at 15, lines 7-10.” It should read: Mr. Slusher further testified “that **granting this application would be just[,] reasonable[,] and in the public interest. Id.** at 15, lines 7-10.” The second error is in the second sentence of the second paragraph, which reads: “Because there is no objection to the granting of the application, the Commission thus presumes the application for approval of indirect transfer of control is in the public interest.” It should read: Because there is no objection to the granting of the application, the Commission thus presumes the application for approval of **transfer of customers and certain assets** is in the public interest. The third error is in the ordering paragraph, which reads: “For the foregoing reasons, the Commission approves the transfer of control of Pac-West Telecomm, Inc. to TNCI Operating Company LLC (“TNCI”).” It should

read: For the foregoing reasons, the Commission approves the **transfer of customers and certain assets** of Pac-West Telecomm, Inc. to TNCI Operating Company LLC (“TNCI”).

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
